# From the Paston's Office

Pastor Kayla will be starting parental leave this month. The timeline on this will depend on baby's arrival but before January ends. Because this is a first for Our Saviour's, to have a pastor on parental leave, here is some information that may be helpful during this time to help members understand who to call during these weeks.

What does this mean? Pastor Kayla will be tending to her family and her own healing during this season. While she continues to be a member of our community and will be participating in community events, she will not be actively working in the role of pastor until her leave ends. If you have a question or need during this time, please do not call Pastor Kayla but refer to the list below to get the answers and help you need.

What if I have an emergency that requires a pastor? Our conference has wonderful pastors nearby who are on call to help you. Pastor Brooke is your first call in these moments, and depending on the timeline of this need, Pastor Carter or Pastor Jessica will also be available.

What constitutes as an pastoral emergency during this time? Pastoral emergencies are things that cannot wait until Pastor Kayla returns. If you or a loved one are hospitalized, in crisis, or are faced with death, please do not hesitate to call one of our on-call pastors to help you. However, know these pastors have their own congregations to tend to, so only use them in the case of emergencies. Desiring a routine visit, having questions about church schedules, or needing the church unlocked are not emergencies. Please use the numbers below to direct those questions.

When will Pastor Kayla be back? Pastor Kayla will rejoin us by Palm Sunday.

Can we stop by the parsonage to visit? Please call ahead and see how the family is adjusting before dropping by. While the parsonage is a church property, it is important to respect Pastor Kayla's time and space during this leave period and they will not always be open or ready for visitors. However, the family welcomes visits if members call ahead to check on schedules and wellness.
